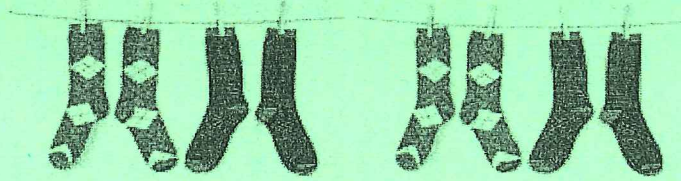


## LEVEL ONE - DRESS-UPS

Answers the question **WHAT KIND?**

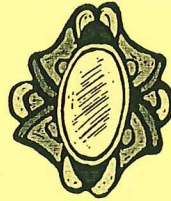
Example: Amy nervously entered the enormous, silent classroom because she hadn't studied for the test.
