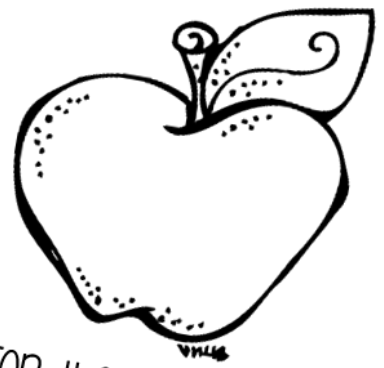
### Bible Memory:
